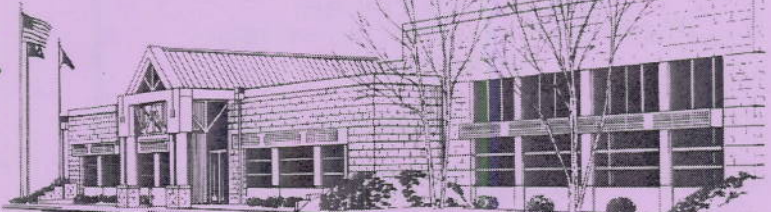

President's Report Paul Jungen II

Since the beginning of this agreement, between October 2009 and December 2009, the Company hired zero. In 2010, the Company hired 494 and so far in 2011, there has been 410 hired. Since October through December 2009, there were 13 retirements. In 2010, 138 members retired and so far in 2011, we have had 44 members retire. There are 34 projected retirements for the remainder of 2011.

Please contact me and give me the date, what Dr. you were trying to schedule with, and how long it took to get an appointment. For those who have experienced long wait times to be seen at an Urgent Care facility, I would like to know about those examples as well.

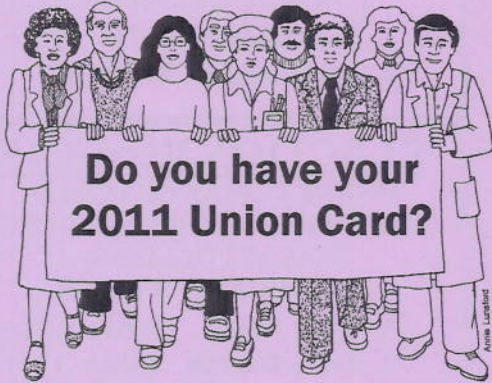

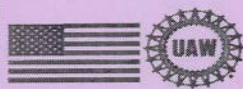


When: Saturday June 4th.

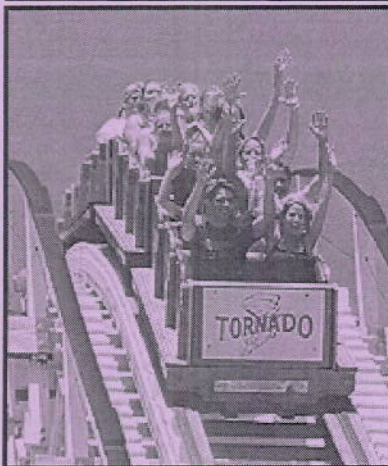


UAW Night at the Ballpark!
